



Dress Code Silverton Middle School

Silverton middle School wants to ensure that student's behavior and dress are appropriate. Students dress and grooming should be modest, neat and clean to ensure the health, safety and comfort of all students.

1. For safety reasons, footwear must be worn at all times.
2. Inappropriate clothing will not be allowed, including clothing that shows undergarments.
3. Items of clothing that are not to be worn at Silverton middle school include the following: Any clothing with gang symbols or gang affiliation, weapons, drug/ alcohol references, profanity or any offensive image.
4. Any clothing that is racist in nature, sexual or demeaning.
5. Pants are to be worn on the hips or above.
6. Immodest clothing such as tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, muscle shirts, backless shirts, see-through attire, clothing that exposes undergarments or midriff is prohibited. Straps must be at least two finger tips wide.
7. Shorts/ Skirts need to be longer than fingertip length and/ or mid-thigh.
8. Sunglasses, trench coats and gloves are to be worn outside.
9. Hats are to be worn on Thursday only unless otherwise communicated, hats are welcomed on campus on designated dress up/ spirit days, otherwise they need to be kept at home.

Any article of clothing that is deemed a distraction to the educational process may be unallowable/ impermissible per staffs' discretion. If necessary, the student's item will be confiscated until parents can pick it up, and students may be provided with clothing or call home to have parents provide appropriate clothing. Further incidents may result in disciplinary action.
